- 2.55-3.15 Story and get ready for home time



Behaviour is a form of communication


We believe that all behaviour is a form of communication. Our aim is to have calm and consistent adults who build positive relationships with the children in order to help manage their feelings and emotions.

The 7 areas of learning


Do you know what they are?





Pencil Grip

Remind your child how to hold their pencil — this supports their control over the pencil and comfort (by being more comfortable children will build their stamina for writing).





How you can support your child at home

- Phonic sound cards
- Handwriting
- Reading daily (to begin with you may need to read parts with your child to develop their stamina)
- Forming letters in their name
- High frequency word sheet
- Counting songs
