




- At Ridgeway, we use the Unlocking Letters and Sounds phonics scheme

- Blend in their head with increasing fluency and confidence;
- Spot digraphs and trigraphs in words before they read.



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Phonics Screening Check



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Phonics Screening Check

- Year 1 children across the country take part in the Phonics Screening Check in June (8th-12th)
- Any children in Year 2 who did not achieve the required standard will take the check during this week too
- The check is designed to confirm whether individual children have learned sufficient decoding and blending skills
- The results will be reported to you as part of your child's annual school report.



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





Preparation for the check

What is the Phonics Screening Check?


- It is a quick check of your child's phonic knowledge
- It is not designed to create any stress or anxiety for your child
- It assesses decoding skills using phonics
- It consists of 40 words (20 real words and 20 pseudo words)
- The pass mark has always been 32 out of 40 but this could change
- If children do not achieve the required score in Year 1, they will retake the screening at the end of Year 2.





How does the check work?


- Your child will sit with a member of staff that they know and have previously practised with
- They will be asked to read 40 words aloud
- This takes just a few minutes to complete but there is no time limit
- If your child is struggling, the adult will stop
- It has been carefully designed not to be stressful for your child
- Your child has already completed practise versions of the phonics screening check in school with us





What are pseudo words?

- These are nonsense words shown to the children next to a picture of an alien (alien words)
- They are a collection of letters that follow the phonics rules
- Their aim is to see if children can recognise a grapheme in any unfamiliar word
- They check children's knowledge of the graphemes they have been taught in both Reception and Year 1
- Children need to know these graphemes in order to be able to read





Reading at Home

The most important thing that you can do is read with your child.

Reading books will help your child to:

- Understand words and sentences
- Use a wide range of vocabulary
- Develop comprehension and listening skills



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
